MUSIC

Repertoire for each festival has been chosen and placed in Division I or II (see listings.) Choirs shall select and prepare music from either division plus the massed ringing pieces. ALL MUSIC IS TO BE PREPARED IN ADVANCE OF THE FESTIVALS. PHOTOCOPIED MUSIC IS ILLEGAL AND NOT PERMITTED.

LOCATION & SCHEDULE

The festivals will be in the gymnasium of First United Methodist Church of Richardson. Check-in and set-up will begin at 8:30 a.m. with the first rehearsal at 9:30 a.m. Both festivals will conclude with a concert at 4:00 p.m.

REGISTRATION

To participate in either festival, complete the enclosed registration form (may be photocopied) and mail it with a **deposit of \$60-choir registration by February 4, 2010**. Remaining balance (ringer registration and table rental) is due no later than March 1, 2010. Registration is limited to available floor space and choirs are assigned positions based upon the date the initial registration is received and by which division that choir is in. You will receive email confirmation. (Please print clearly.)

COFFEE SERVICE

A coffee service including sweet rolls will be offered. Donations are encouraged to defray GDHA costs and to enable us to continue this service.

LUNCH

Lunch is not included in the registration fee. A local restaurant guide will be available at the festivals or groups may elect to bring their own lunch and gather as a group on campus. The time of each lunch period will be determined by the Division in which your choir rings.
